Government 'Bereavement Payment'	You may be able to get a £2,000 Bereavement Payment if your spouse or civil partner died before 6 April 2017. This is a one-off, tax-free, lump-sum payment. You may also be eligible for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Widowed Parent's Allowance - if you're bringing up children • Bereavement Allowance You don't have to apply more than once - you'll be considered for all bereavement benefits when you apply for one.	https://www.gov.uk/bereavement-payment

Funeral directors	Payment plans	Please discuss options with your chosen funeral director, or discuss payment options with different directors to see what your options are. Some may offer payment plans and payments by instalments.
Crowd funding	These days, more and more families are getting help with funeral costs through online crowdfunding – setting up online profiles that friends and family members can visit to donate money towards the funeral. One service that is available is: Beyond Life, who offer free online obituaries designed for crowdfunding funerals: it takes just a few minutes to set up a tribute page that people can visit to share memories and contribute funds.
